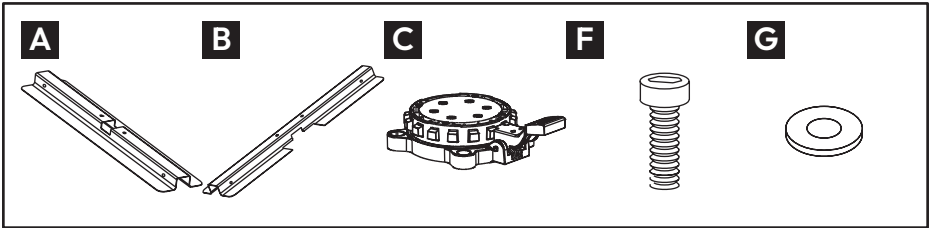
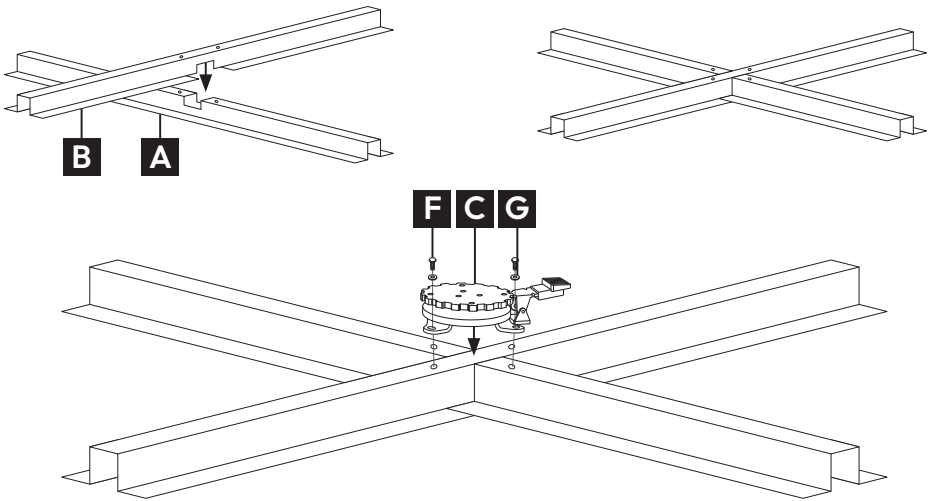
Before you start:

- This parasol requires additional base weights; we recommend a minimum of 80kg or heavier.
- Do not over-tighten the crank, this will cause excessive stress on the crank cord which could lead to fraying or snapping.
- Do not leave the parasol up when not in use or during windy and wet conditions.

Assembly

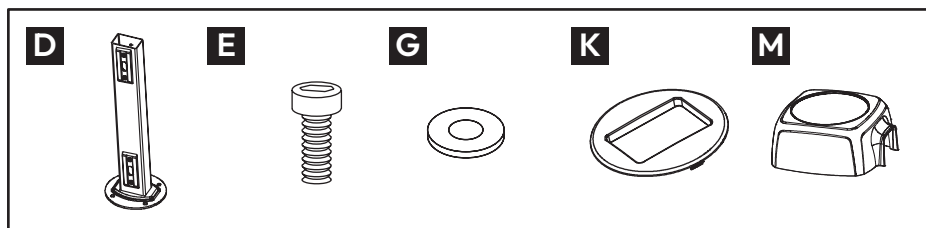
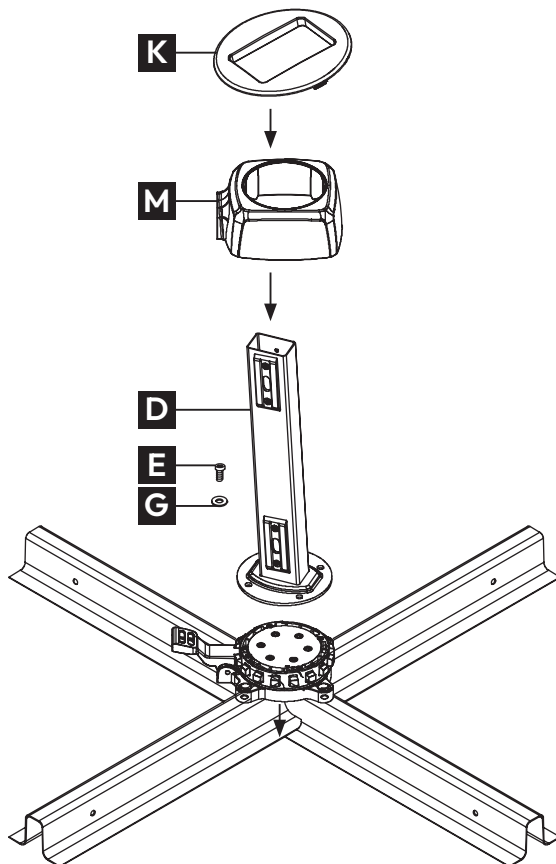
STEP 1

Position the top cross section over the bottom cross section. Position the base plate onto the cross sections. Loosely secure the M8 x 20mm screws and washers, once in place tighten all the bolts with the Allen key.



STEP 2

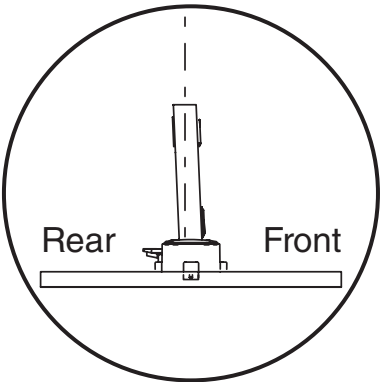
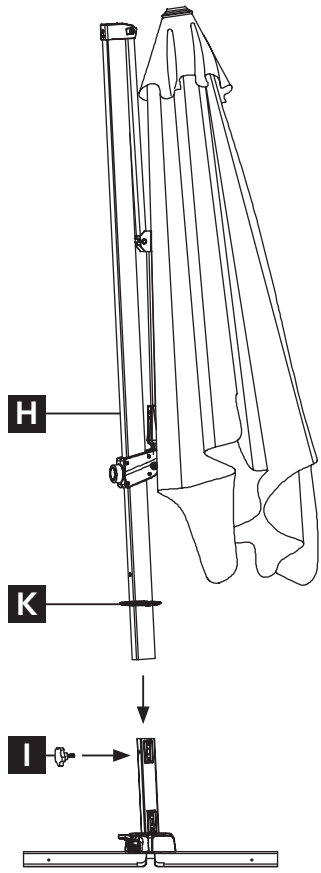
Position the base stand onto the base plate. Loosely secure the M8 x 14mm screws and washers, once in place tighten all the bolts with the Allen key. Position the base cap plate and the base cap cover over the base stand.



Assembly

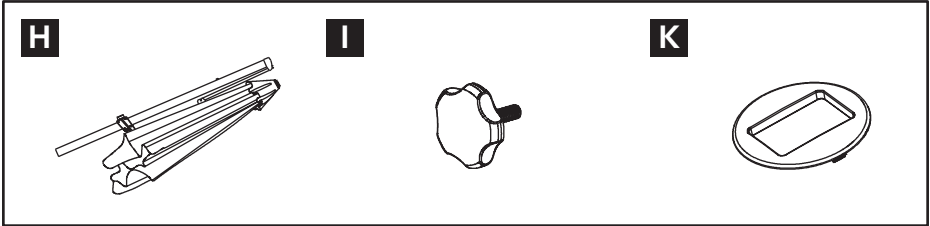
STEP 3

Slide the parasol onto the base stand; ensure that the handle of the parasol is placed at the rear of the base stand. Screw the thumb screw into the rear of the base stand.



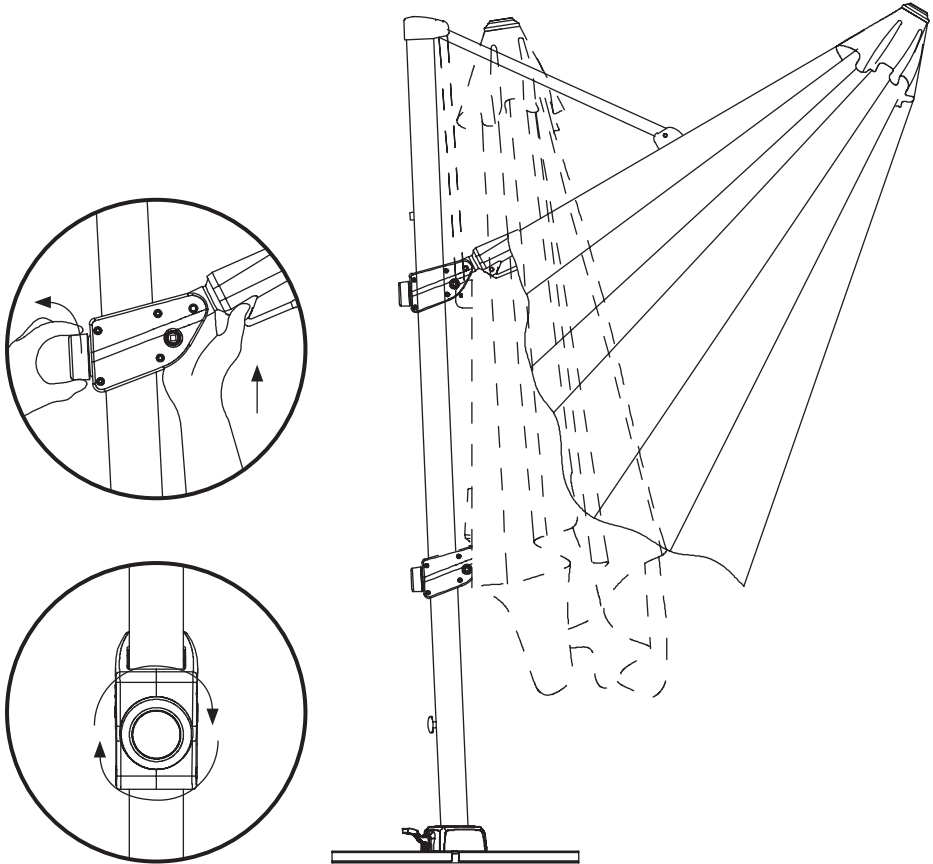
Complete

Assembly of the parasol is now complete.



Operating the parasol

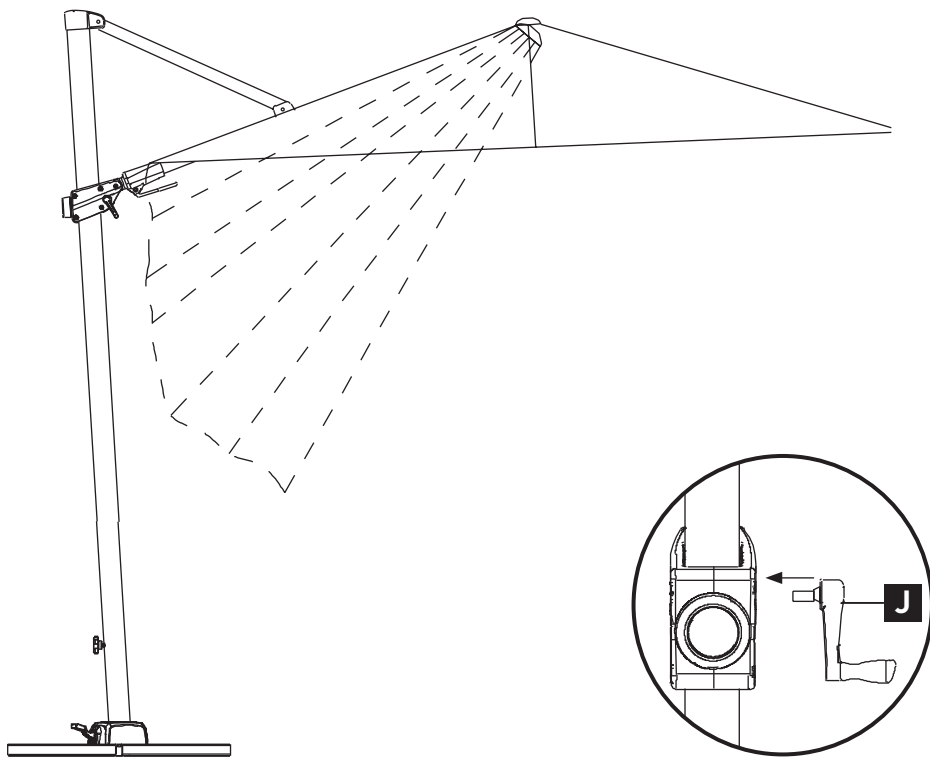
To raise and lower the parasol, turn the dial on the back of the crank handle. Turn clockwise to raise and anticlockwise to lower.

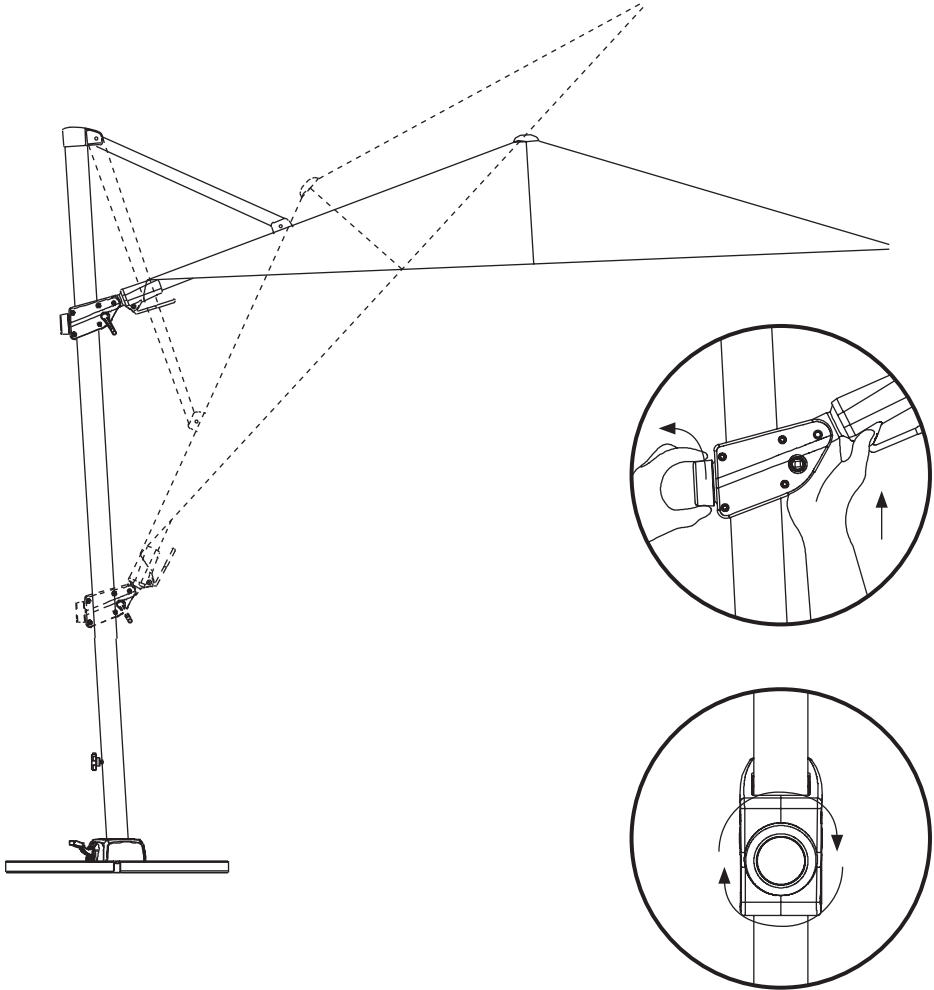
Operating the parasol

To open and close the parasol, place the crank handle into the handle of the parasol. Turn clockwise to open and anticlockwise to close.



Operating the parasol

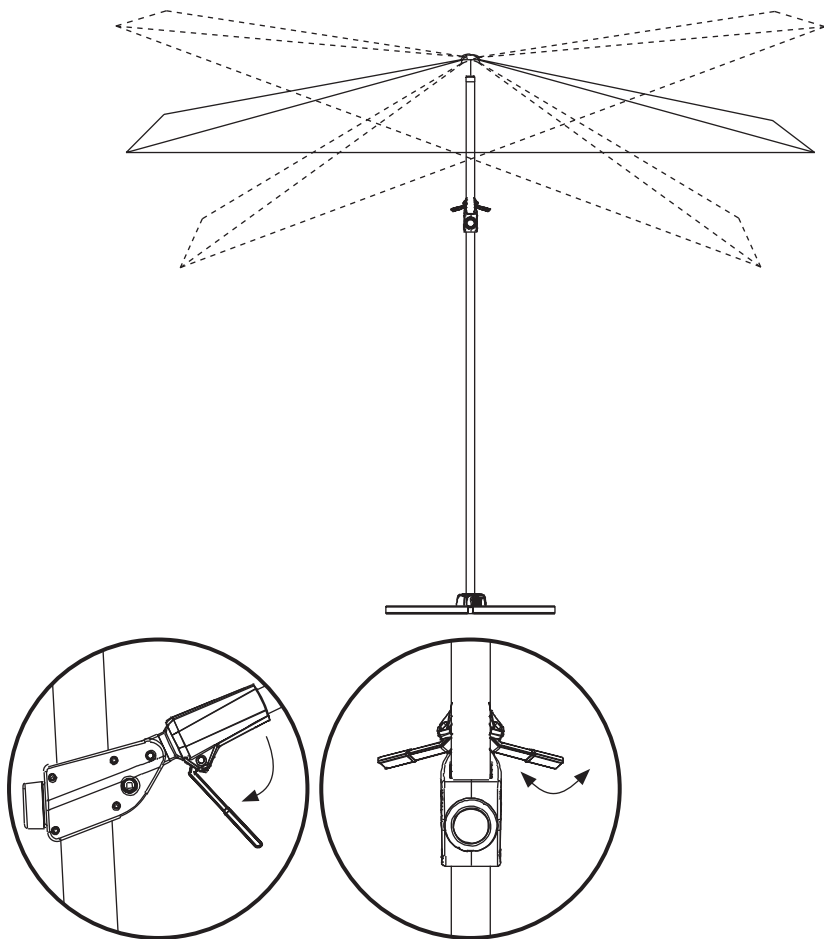
To tilt the parasol, turn the dial on the back of the crank handle. Turn clockwise to raise and anticlockwise to lower.



How to operate

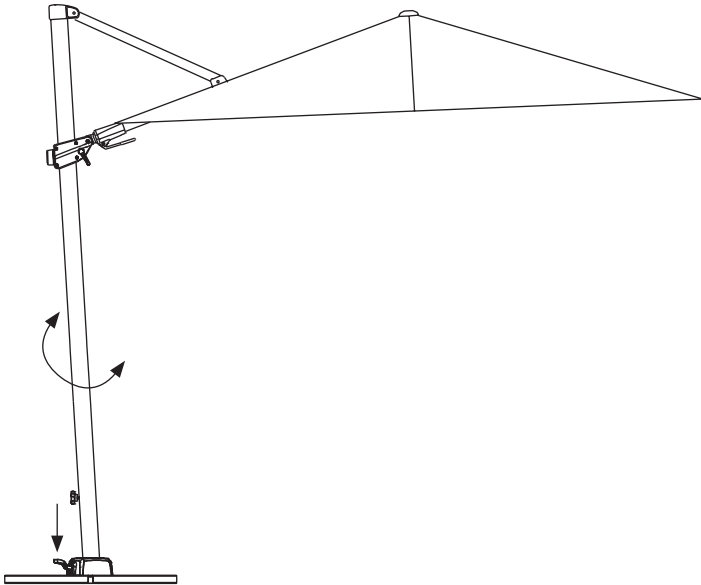
Tilting the parasol

To tilt the parasol, pull the internal lever downwards and rotate with the lever into the desired position. Once in the desired position, push the lever back up to lock into place.



Rotating the parasol

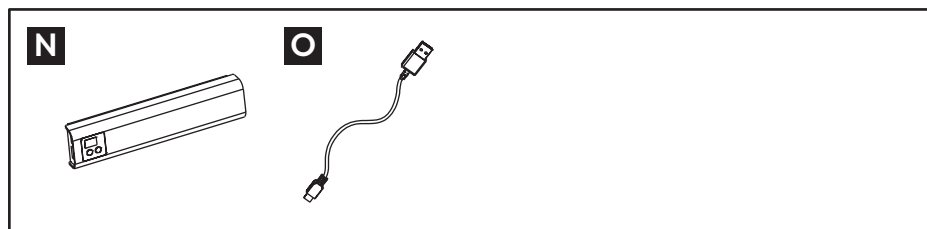
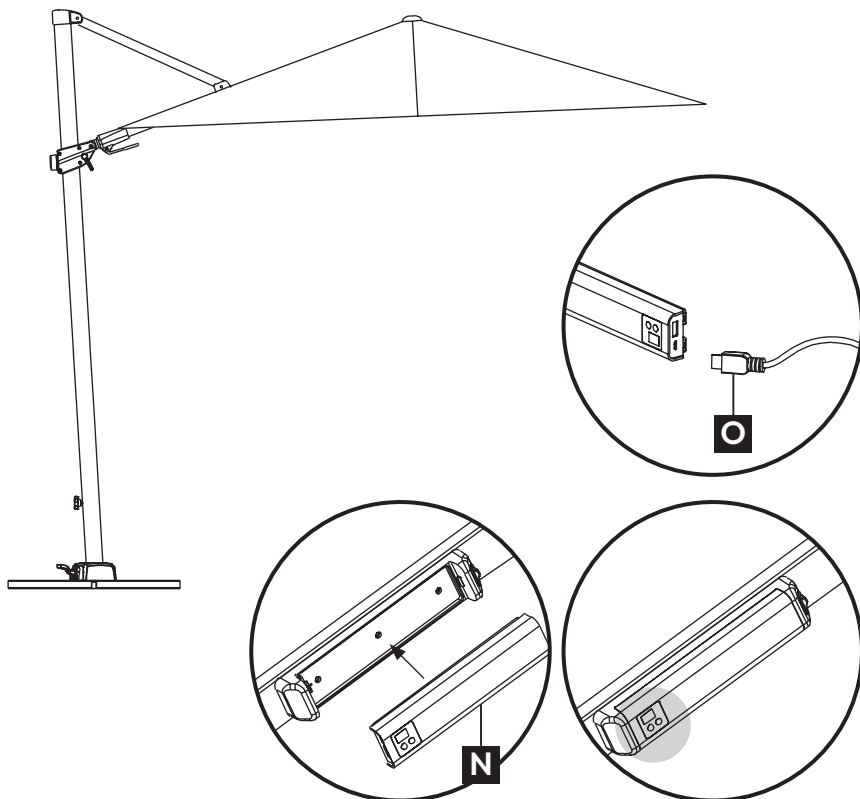
To rotate the parasol, press down on the pedal with your foot and rotate the parasol. Once in the desired position release the pedal.



How to operate

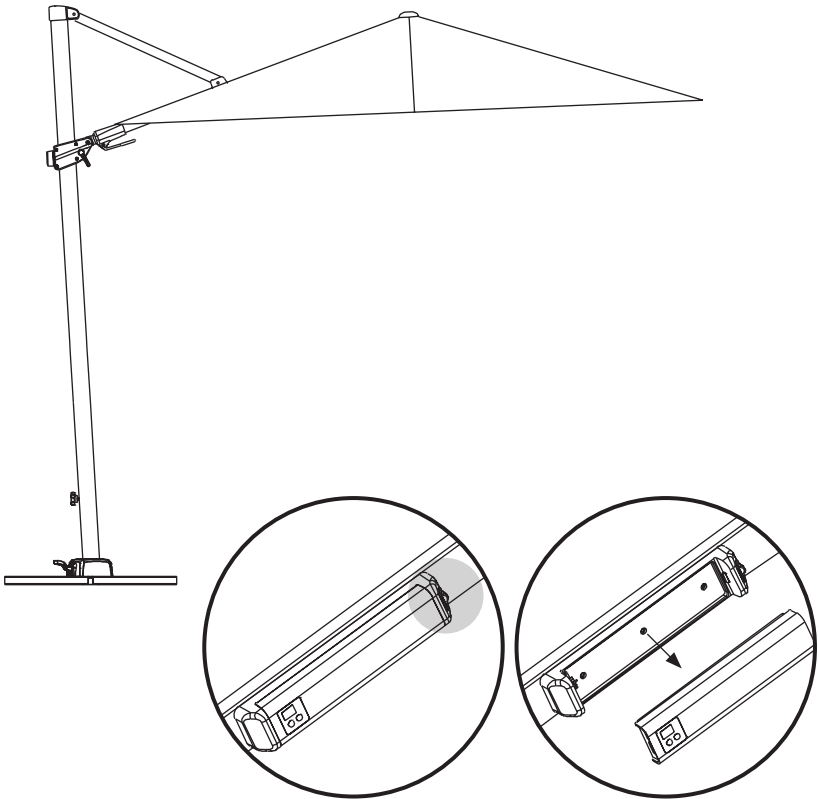
Operating LED lights

To operate the LED lights, simply attach the battery pack to the parasol and press the button to turn on and off. To charge the battery pack, connect the USB cable to the battery pack and a suitable outlet.



Operating LED lights

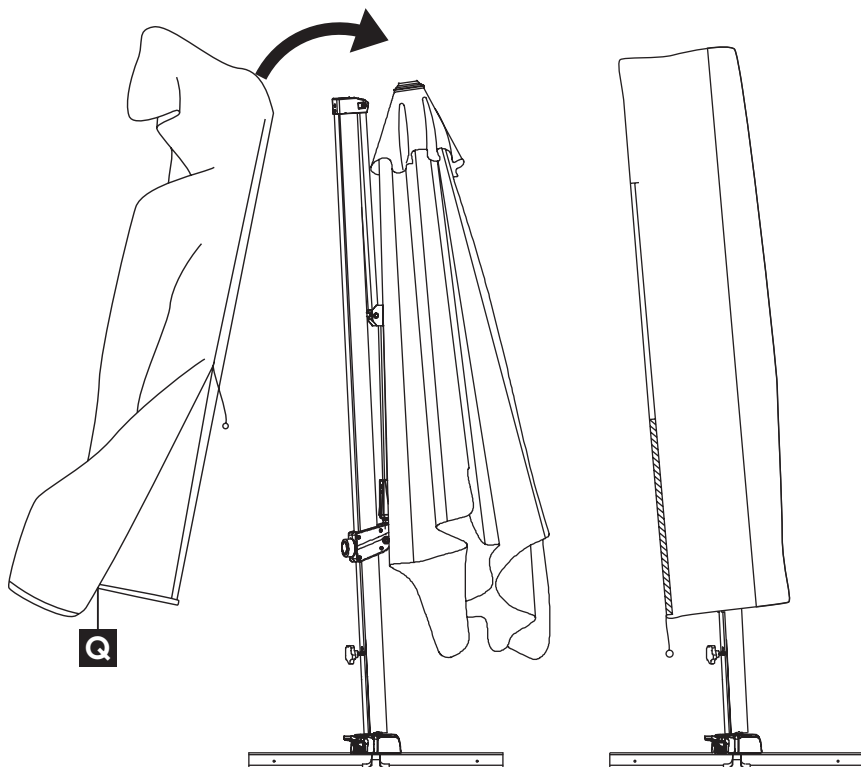
To remove the battery pack, simply press on the button at the end of the battery pack and it will release from the housing.

Adding the cover

When not in use, close the parasol and unzip the rod assist cover. Slide the cover over the parasol, fasten the zip and secure with the drawstrings.
