SAFETY ADVICE - BEFORE YOU START

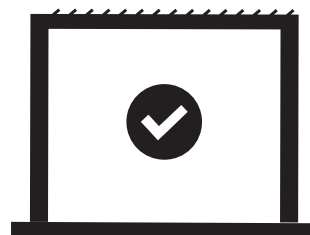
- Ensure that you read this manual before starting to assemble your Pergola.

ASSEMBLING THE PERGOLA

- The ground where the Pergola is built should be solid but with at least a 1-2° decline to allow to the rainwater to drain away.
- If the Pergola is built on completely flat surface, the rainwater will not drain away and the Pergola will start leaking.

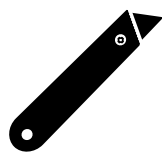
Sloped

- The Pergola should not be assembled directly under trees and powerlines.

Use a spirit level to ensure that Part E will be at the same level as the ground.



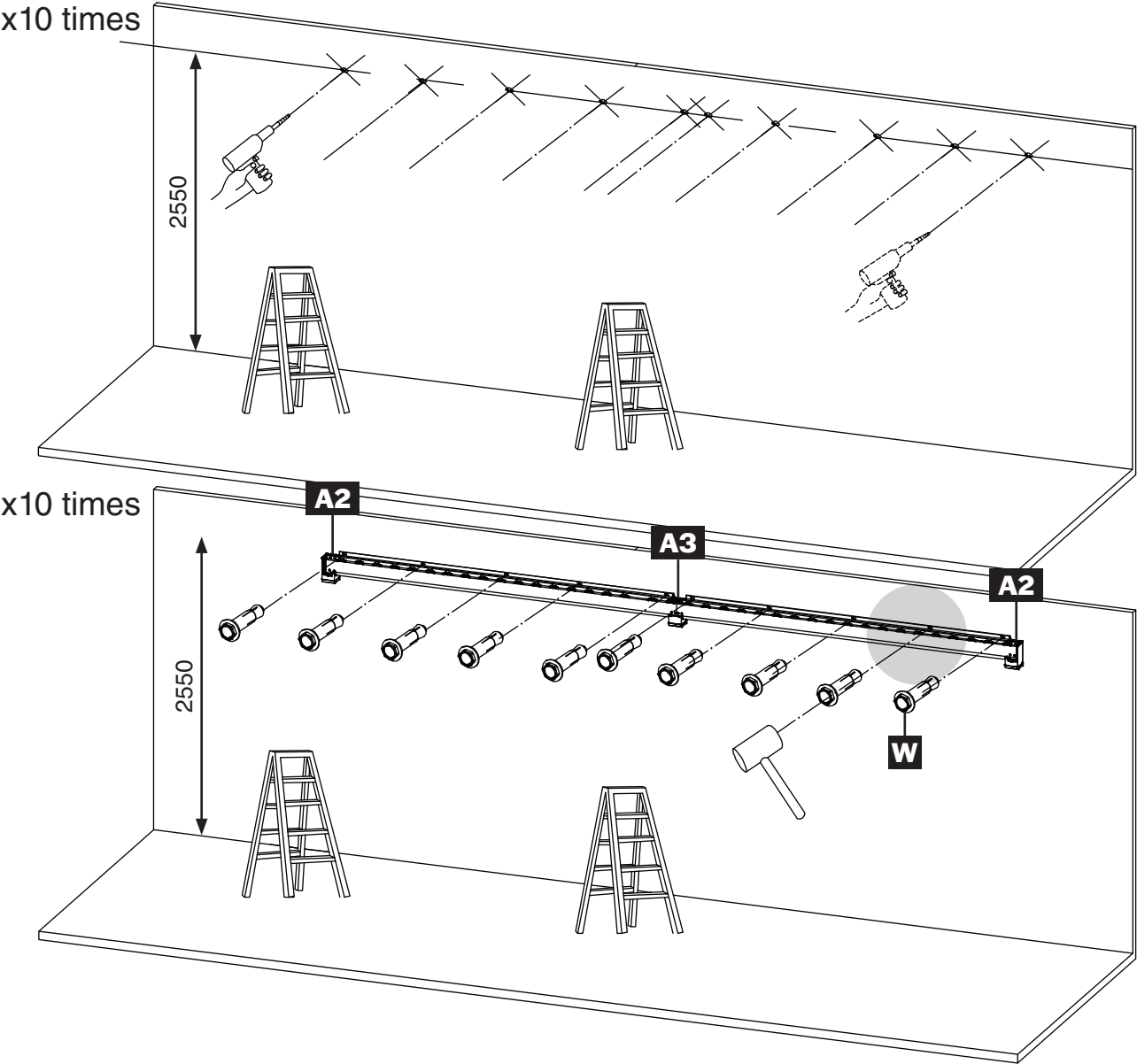
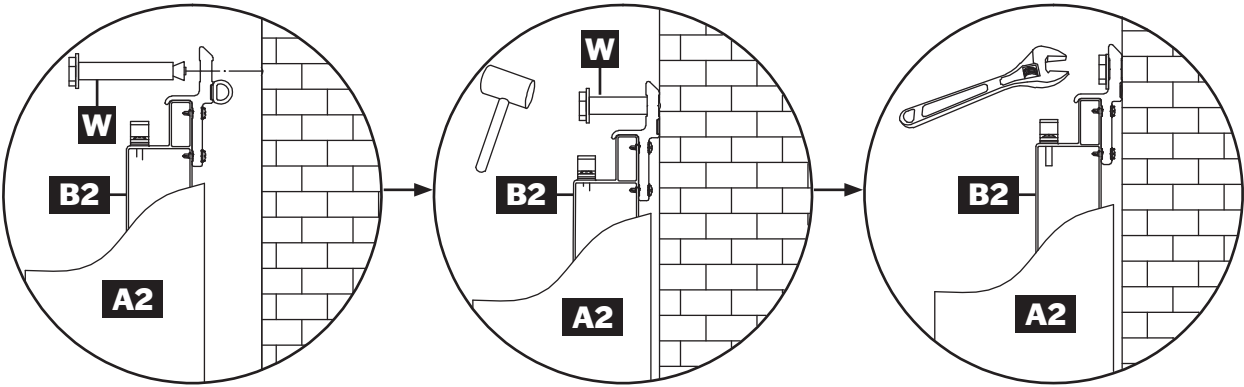
The pergola will be slightly higher against the side of the wall to facilitate the flow of the water from high to low when it rains.

If waterproof performance is highly required, please prepare glass glue by yourself and apply onto the contact surface between the beam fixing part and the wall.

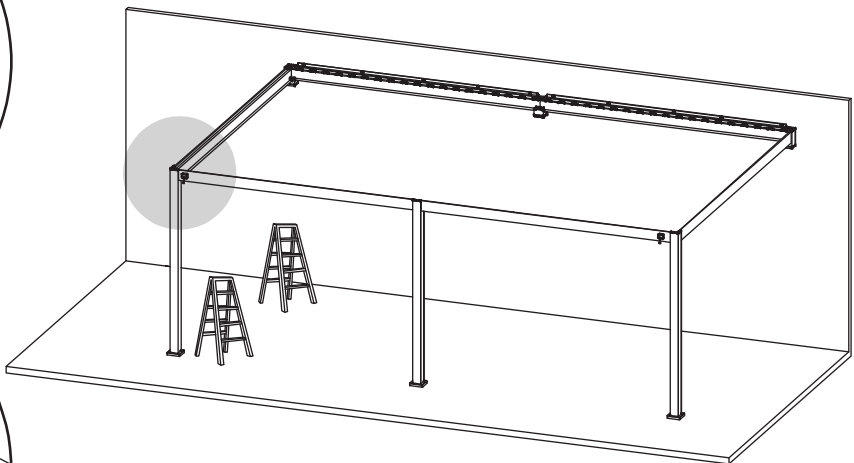
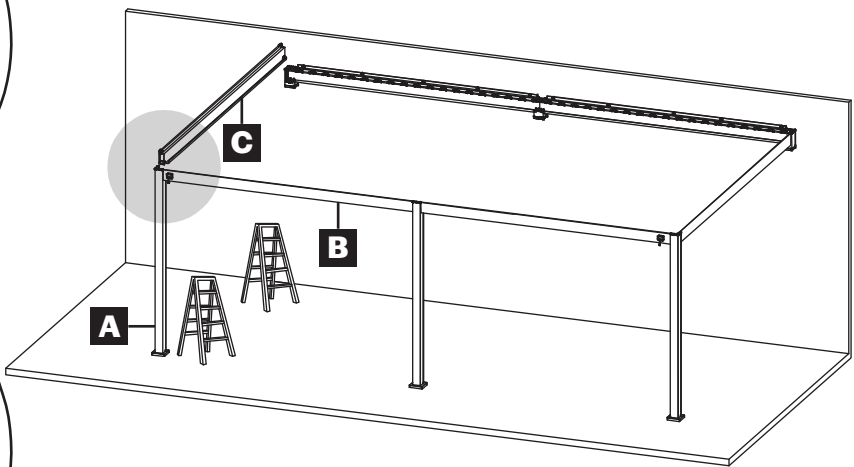
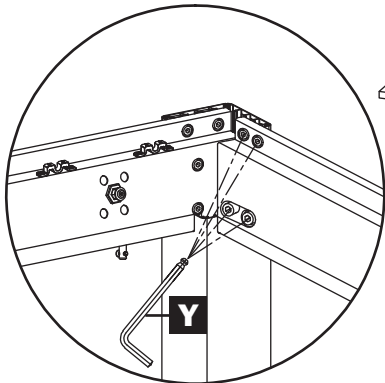
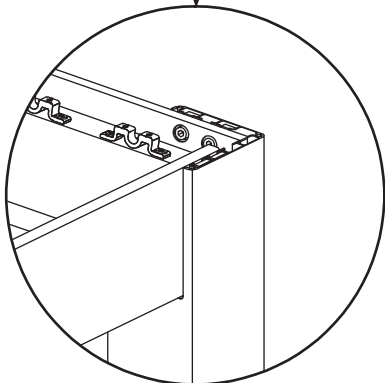
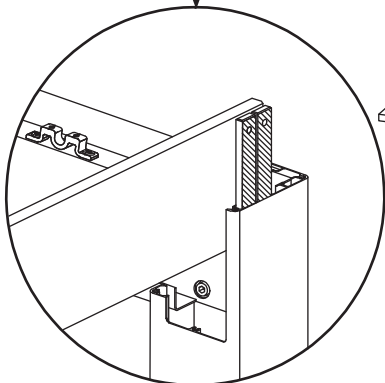
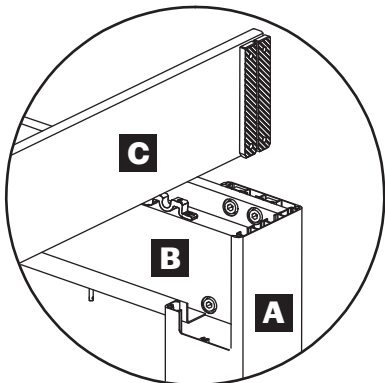

CARE & WARRANTY INFORMATION

CARING FOR YOUR PERGOLA

- Debris can be built up inside the gutters of the Pergola, therefore it is important to clean the gutters regularly as this will allow rainwater to flow through the Pergola.
- Never place any objects on top of the Louvres.
- During snowfall and heavy winds, open the Louvres into the vertical position to prevent damage.
- Do not operate the roof mechanism during frosty and icy conditions.
- To clean, simply use a soft cloth that is damp with warm soapy water and wipe down. This material can be left outside all year round.
- Regularly check that the Pergola is firmly fixed to the ground.
- Regularly check that all fixings are secured within the Pergola.
