SAFETY ADVICE - BEFORE YOU START

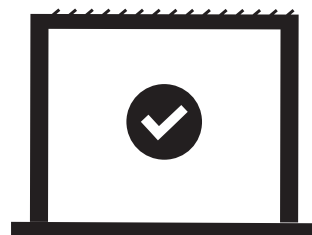
- Ensure that you read this manual before starting to assemble your Pergola.

ASSEMBLING THE PERGOLA

- The ground where the Pergola is built should be solid but with at least a 1-2° decline to allow to the rainwater to drain away.
- If the Pergola is built on completely flat surface, the rainwater will not drain away and the Pergola will start leaking.

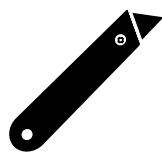
Sloped

- The Pergola should not be assembled directly under trees and powerlines.

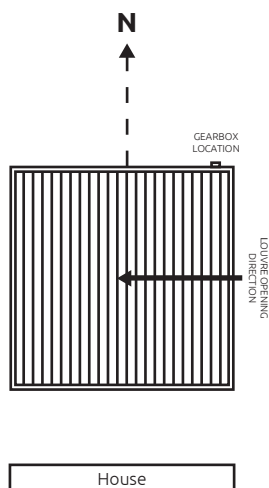
THE RECOMMENDED LOUVRE POSITION

The louvres and gearbox location can be placed in your preferred position. However, for optimum use, the louvres should follow the sun. Please use the guide below to position the Pergola in the recommended position according to the sun's rise and set.

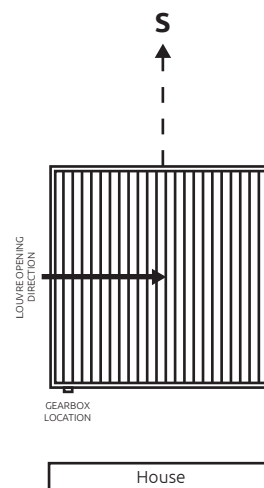
TOP TIP

Keep the gearbox location as northerly as possible

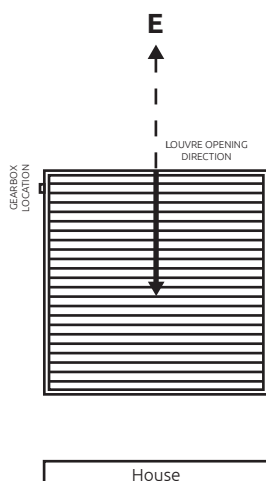

STEP 7 - FRAME ADJUSTMENT

Now you are almost done installing the main frame. Please make sure all legs and beams are installed correctly. You may have to unscrew certain bolts during the adjustment.

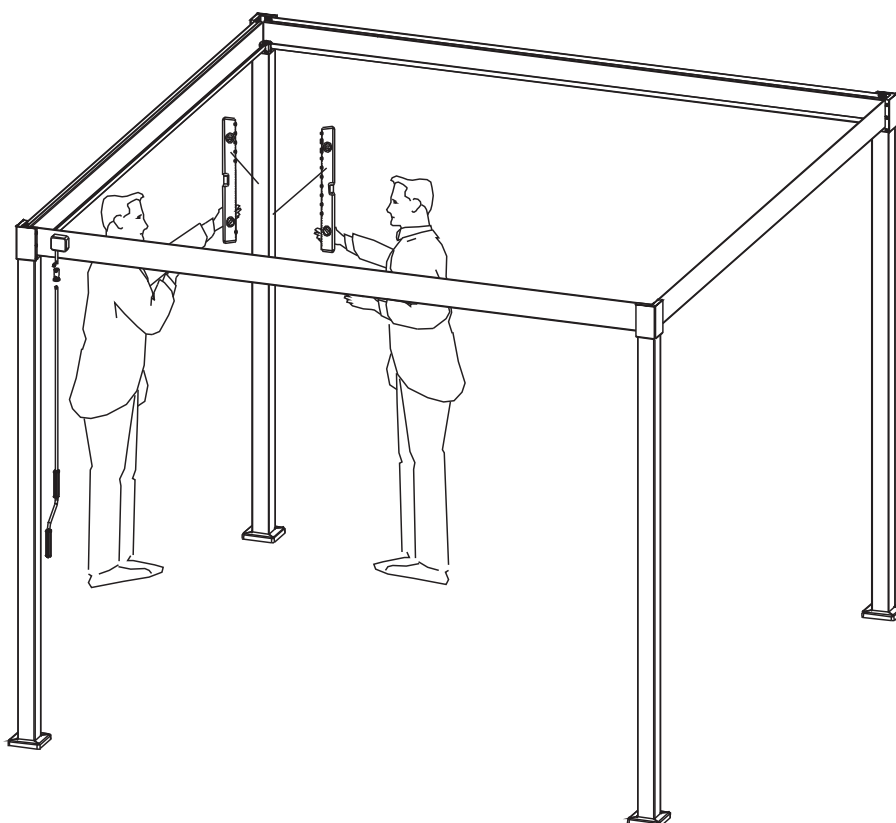

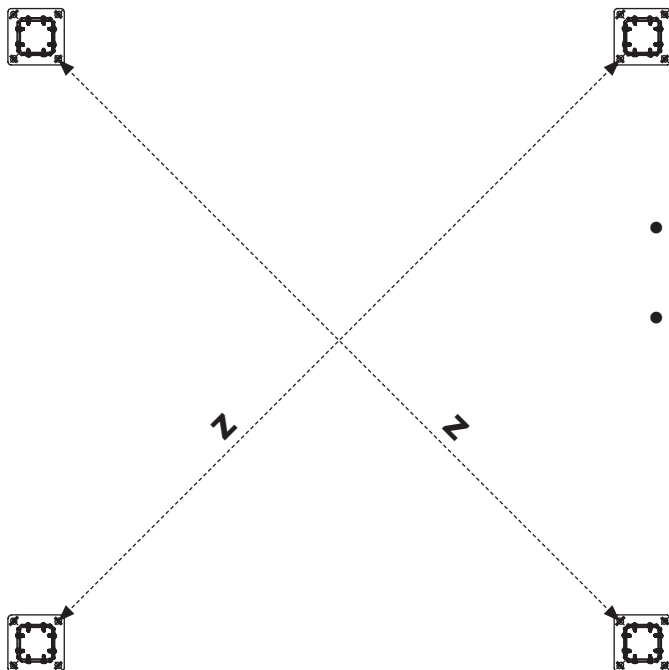
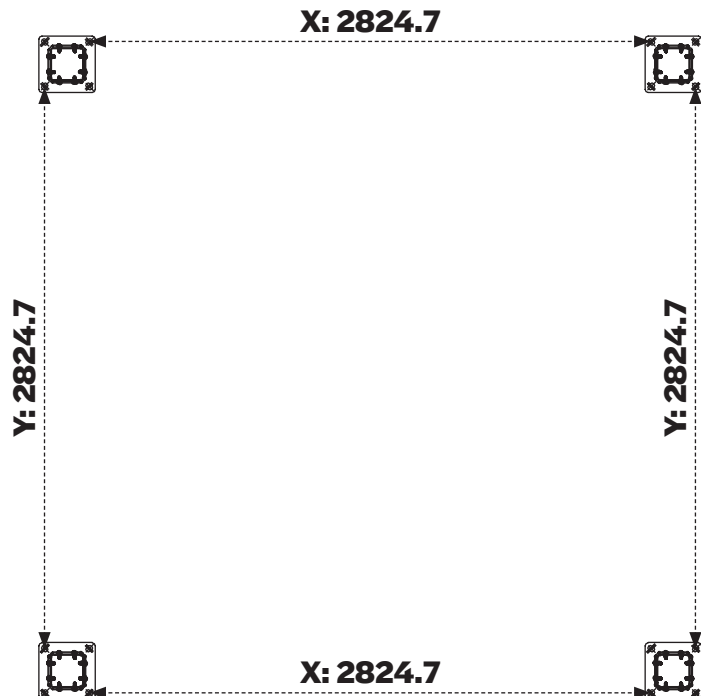
- Choose one leg and work from this leg. This leg will define the final placement location of the pergola.
- Use spirit level to determine whether the leg placement is level.
- Measure against both inner sides of the legs to guarantee the leg is level.
- Do not move this leg in future steps.

STEP 7 CONTINUED

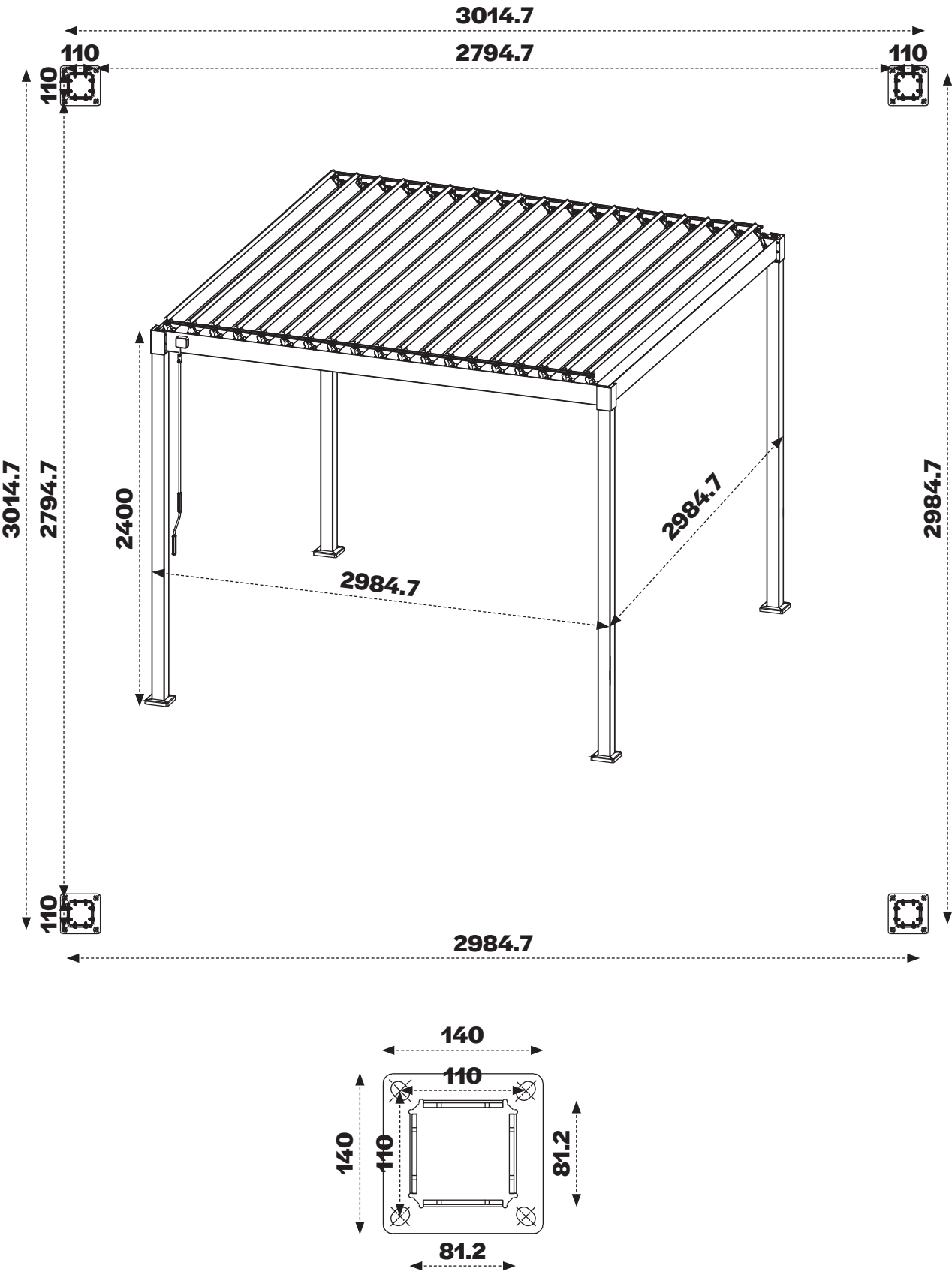
- Measure the distance between adjacent legs.
- Adjust the other 3 legs accordingly until all distances are equal using the guide opposite.



- Measure the diagonal distance between opposite legs.
- Adjust the other 3 legs accordingly until both diagonal distances are equal. You may have to repeat the above steps after this step.

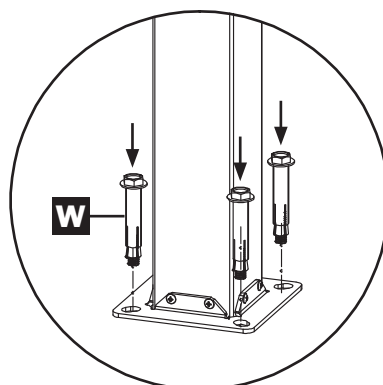
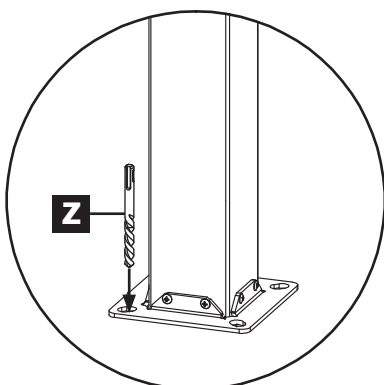
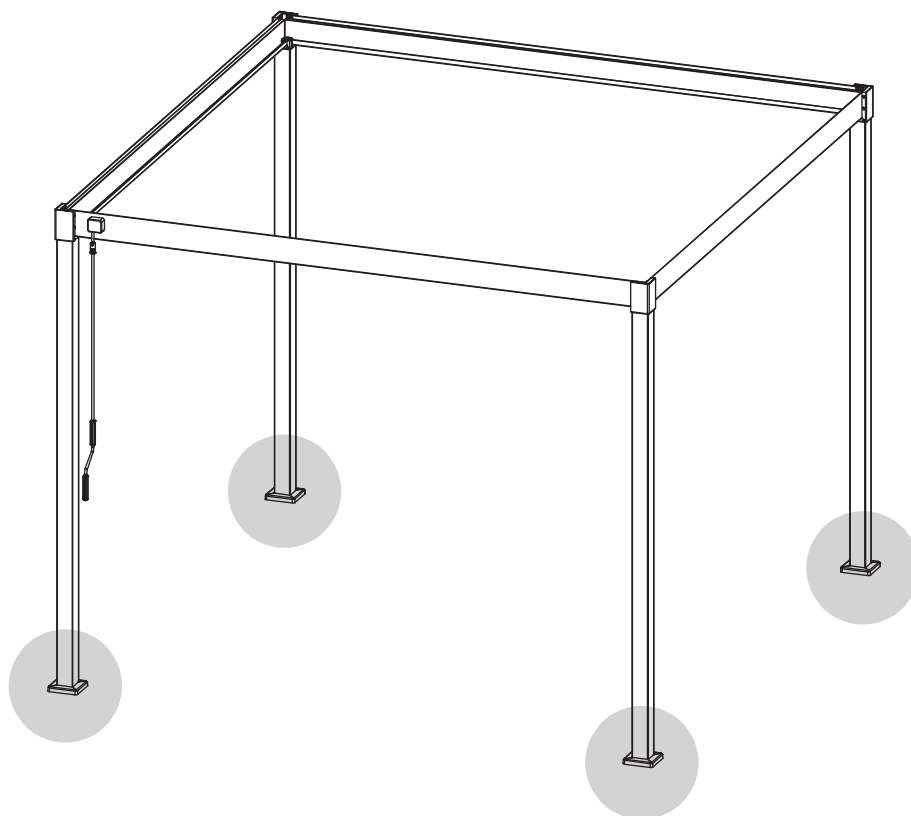
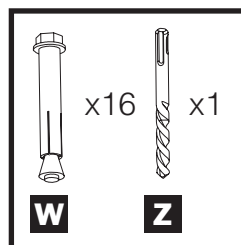
- Check if all legs are level using a spirit level.
- Check if all beams are level using a spirit level.
- If not level, it means your main building surface wasn't sufficiently level and you shall need to raise the pergola legs that are positioned lower than others.
- If you do not adjust the main structure, there could be problems with louvres and/or accessories that are to be placed in the frame.

CARING FOR YOUR PERGOLA

- Debris can be built up inside the gutters of the Pergola, therefore it is important to clean the gutters regularly as this will allow rainwater to flow through the Pergola.
- Never place any objects on top of the Louvres.
- During snowfall and heavy winds, open the Louvres into the vertical position to prevent damage.
- Do not operate the roof mechanism during frosty and icy conditions.
- To clean, simply use a soft cloth that is damp with warm soapy water and wipe down. This material can be left outside all year round.
- Regularly check that the Pergola is firmly fixed to the ground.
- Regularly check that all fixings are secured within the Pergola.
