Safety Advice - Before you start

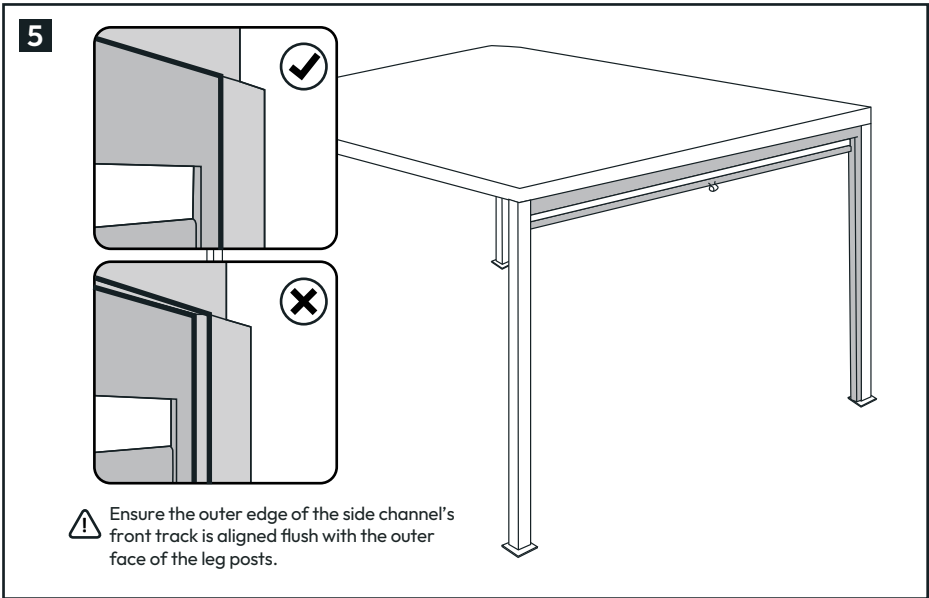
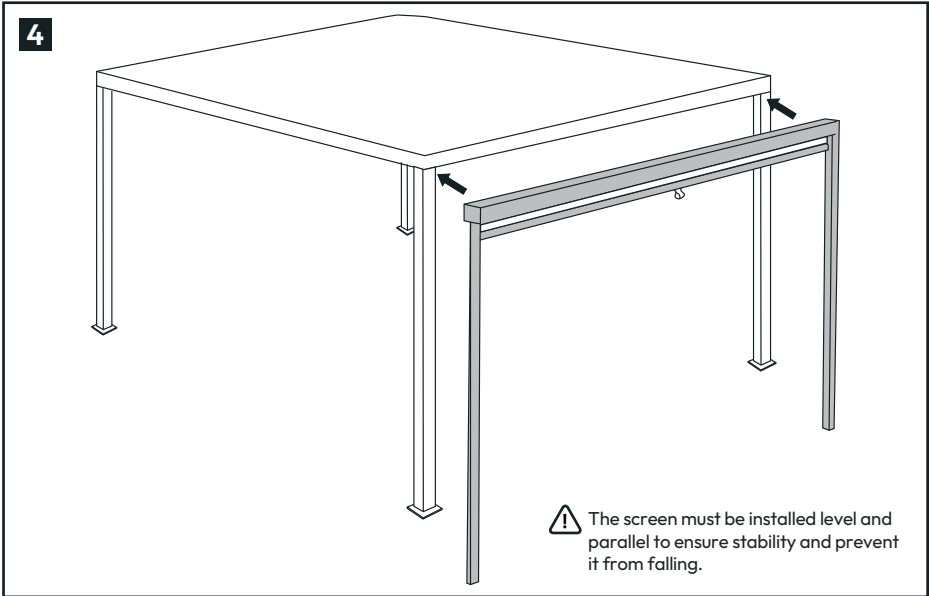
- This product contains heavy components. Take care when lifting and assembling; two-person installation is recommended.

When the screen is installed on the front (side with the gearbox), the top cassette should be flush with the front beam, not the leg posts. This will stop the screen from interfering with the gearbox and handle.







Care & Maintenance

- Wipe rails and components with a soft cloth and mild soapy water.
- Brush off loose dirt regularly.
- Keep tracks clear - Remove dust, leaves, and debris from the side channels/guide tracks to ensure smooth operation.
- Inspect periodically - Check screws, caps, and rails for loosening, wear, or damage. Tighten or replace as needed.
